It will take approximately 30 business days to receive final approval from your Association. All requests for modification to your property should be **HAND DELIVERED**, **MAILED**, or **EMAILED** to our office address/email address listed below.

What is required?

- 1. Architectural Modification Request Form signed and initialed by homeowner along with a detailed description of the planned modification project.
- 2. Sample of the material(s) to be used in modification project.

For example, a painting project will require:

- Actual color swatch/color number
- Color pictures
- Product brand/manufacturer/brochure
- 3. Specs of product(s).
- 4. Scope of work. Pricing does not need to be included.
- 5. Survey of the property and location of where item(s) of modification will be placed. Include a drawing with measurements of your modification.
- 6. Copy of up-to-date, valid contractor License.
- 7. Certificate of Insurance from the contractor company.

 Under certificate holder, provide homeowner first & last name and property address.
